Chateau Herbicide label expanded via Minor Use Program for use on garlic

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) recently announced the approval of a minor use label expansion registration for **Chateau® Herbicide for control of labeled weeds on garlic in Canada**. Chateau® Herbicide was already labeled for use on a number of crops in Canada for control of several weeds.

This minor use project was submitted by the national minor use program at Agriculture & Agri-Food Canada, Pest Management Centre as a result of minor use priorities established by growers and extension personnel.

The following is provided as an abbreviated, general outline only. Users should be making weed management decisions within a robust integrated weed management program and should consult the complete label before using **Chateau® Herbicide**.

Crop(s)	Target	Rate (kg/ha)	Application Information	PHI (days)
Garlic	Labeled weeds	280-420 depending upon soil type	Apply prior to weed emergence. Apply prior to emergence of garlic and within 3 days after planting garlic. Apply only once per growing season.	N/A
