- The National Pickle Packers Association (precursor to PPI) was founded in 1893 as a promotional agency responsible for educating consumers about the health benefits of eating pickling cucumbers.
- In 1933, National Pickle Packers Association was incorporated and based in St. Charles, Illinois. (Pickle Capital of the World).
- In 2005, PPI's BOD decided to use a 3rd party association management company and moved PPI to Washington, DC and engaged with the association management company, Verto Solutions.
- Next year 2024 will mark the 130th year of the Association

Michigan State University > Mary Hausbeck

- Downy Mildew > \$82,500/yr. for 5 years
- Downy Mildew Early detection > \$19,000/yr.

University of Wisconsin > Dr Weng

- DM Resistance Breeding > \$20,000/yr. for 3 years
- Pyramiding DM & Phytophthhora Fruit Rot Resistances > \$9,500/yr. for 3 years.

NC State > Lena Quesada

- Downy Mildew > \$82,500/yr. for 5 years
- Downy Mildew Control Options > \$5,000/ yr. for 3 years
