MARKET intelligence

2020 Harvest

Despite the challenges associated with COVID-19 and Mother Nature, growers and processors worked together for a successful crop year in 2020.

CARROT HARVEST resulted in 2.26% over contract tonnage.

CUCUMBER HARVEST was down 10.84% from contracted tons, due to challenges sourcing labour.

GREEN AND WAX BEAN ACRES HARVESTED produced 45.3% over contracted acreage.

GREEN PEA HARVEST acreage was slightly below those contracted at -0.097%.

LIMA BEAN HARVEST acres were 2.68% more than acres contracted.

ONION HARVEST tons were down 40.5% over contract tonnage.

SQUASH HARVEST resulted in 2.09% more tons over those contracted.

SWEET CORN HARVEST tons were up 10.42% over contracted tonnage.

TOMATO HARVEST resulted in just over 3.145% additional tons being delivered.

<u>Cucumbers</u> - Agreements were reached for both Hand Harvest and Machine and copies sent to Cucumber growers.

<u>**Onions</u>** - Negotiations concluded with an agreement and a copy was sent to Onion growers.</u>

Sweet Corn - Negotiations for Sweet Corn will begin by Monday, February 8.

<u>Green & Wax Beans</u> - Negotiations for Green & Wax Beans will start by Monday, February 22.

Lima Beans - Negotiations for Lima Beans will begin by Monday, March 1.

Squash - Negotiations for Squash will start by Monday, March 1.
