 Aim Herbicide label expanded via Minor Use Program for control of weeds on mint in Canada

Aim Herbicide label expanded via Minor Use Program for control of weeds on mint in Canada J. Chaput, Minor Use Coordinator, OMAFRA



The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) recently announced the approval of a minor use label expansion registration for **Aim® Herbicide** for control of labelled weeds on mint in Canada. **Aim® Herbicide** was already labeled for use on several crops in Canada for control of weeds.

This minor use project was submitted by Agriculture & Agri-Food Canada, Pest Management Centre (AAFC-PMC) as a result of minor use priorities established by growers and extension personnel.

The following is provided as an abbreviated, general outline only. Users should be making weed management decisions within a robust integrated weed management program and should consult the complete label before using **Aim® Herbicide**.

Crop(s)	Target	Rate (mL/ha)	Application Information	PHI (days)
Mint	Labeled weeds	37 – 117	DORMANCY SPRAY: Apply as a broadcast application before mint breaks dormancy for control of existing broadleaf weeds in a minimum of 100 L water per ha. Use adjuvant as per label instructions	91
Mint	Labeled weeds	37 – 117	PRE-PLANT BURNDOWN APPLICATION: Apply one application to mint in a minimum of 100 L water per ha. Use adjuvant as per label instructions. Do not follow a pre-plant burndown or dormancy spray with a hooded sprayer application of AIM Herbicide.	91
Mint	Labeled weeds	37 – 117	HOODED SPRAYER APPLICATION: Apply one application to mint in a minimum of 100 L water per using a hooded sprayer to control labelled weeds between the rows of mint crops. This treatment must be made to mint crops grown in rows. Do not use this method if a dormancy or pre-plant burndown application has been used.	5
