PURESPRAY GREEN spray oil label expanded via Minor Use Program to help manage aphids on Leafy Vegetables and Wasabi in Canada

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) recently announced the approval of a minor use label expansion registration for PURESPRAY GREEN® spray oil for management of aphids on Crop Group 4-13 (Leafy Vegetables) and wasabi in Canada. PURESPRAY GREEN® spray oil was already labeled for management of insects and powdery mildew on a wide range of crops in Canada. These minor use proposals were submitted by the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food, and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA); and

Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's Pest Management Centre (AAFC-PMC) as a result of minor use priorities established by growers and extension personnel.

The following is provided as an abbreviated, general outline only. Users should be making insect and disease management decisions within a robust integrated pest management program and should consult the complete label before using PURESPRAY GREEN® spray oil.

Crop(s)	Target	Rate (L product / 1000 L of water)	Application Information	
Crop Group 4-13 (Leafy Vegetables) *	Deterrence of feeding by Aphids	10	Ground application only. Begin when aphids appear. Apply at 7-14 day intervals. Maximum 8 applications per year. 1 day pre-harvest interval.	
Wasabi **	Aphids	6.8 – 9	Begin when aphids appear. Apply at 7 day interval. 14 day pre-harvest interval.

TOXIC to aquatic organisms. Observe BUFFER ZONES specified under DIRECTIONS FOR USE. To reduce runoff from treated areas into aquatic habitats avoid application to areas with a moderate to steep slope, compacted soil, or clay. Avoid application when heavy rain is forecast. VCR - Vegetable Crop Report - September 8th, 2022

The VCR (vegetable crop report) is a weekly update which includes crop updates, weather and growing degree summaries for various vegetable growing regions across Ontario.



Temperature – All counties continue to match or surpass their 10 year average GDD trend except for Peterborough. Many regions experienced a few cooler days last week but daytime temperatures are back in the mid- to high- 20s this week for much of the province. Southern Ontario may see nighttime temperatures in the mid-teens to low-20s. Eastern and Northern region nighttime temperatures are expected to range in the teens.

Precipitation – Most regions received some precipitation over the first week of September except for Wellington, Durham and Peterborough. Some rain is expected in most regions at the beginning of next week and it is expected throughout much of next week in Sudbury.

Kemptville and Sudbury also have a risk of thunderstorms on some days.







Chatham-Kent Growing Degree Days


